Subject: Placement of I/C Assistant Executive Engineers (Civil) as I/C Executive Engineer (Civil) in Public Works (R&B) Department.

Government Order No. 85 -PW(R&B) of 2021

Dated: 18 .02.2021

WHEREAS, various vacancies of Executive Engineers (Civil) in PW(R&B) Department became/ or likely to become vacant due to placements/ retirements of various AEEs (Civil); and

WHEREAS, vide SROs 661 & 662 dated 25th October, 2019, the cadre strength of Assistant Executive Engineers (Civil) for the Union Territory of J&K & Ladakh is 184; and

WHEREAS, as per SRO-297 dated 14-09-2006, the method of recruitment for filling up the post of Executive Engineer has been prescribed as:

"80% by promotion from class IV category-A amongst persons possessing Bachelor's Degree in Engineering or AMIE Section (A&B) India with at least 8 years of total Gazetted Service in the same branch of Engineering in which appointment is to made with at least 4 years experience as Assistant Executive Engineer.

20% by promotion from class-IV category-A amongst Diploma holders with at least 10 years total Gazetted Service in the same branch of Engineering in which appointment is to be made with at least 4 years experience as Assistant Executive Engineer.

Provided that if at the time of consideration of promotion eligible officers from one source of appointment (Degree/Diploma) are not available, eligible officers from other source of appointment shall be taken, on stop gap arrangement who shall not have preferential treatment for higher promotion based on stop gap promotion".

WHEREAS, accordingly on the basis of present incumbency of I/c Executive Engineers (Civil) and cadre strength of both (Degree & Diploma) the net resultant vacancies in favour of Degree and Diploma comes to 13 and 31 respectively as shown in the table below:-

WHEREAS, None of the I/c AEE under the category of Diploma Holders (Civil) are presently eligible as per SRO-297 of 2006 for higher placement for I/c Executive Engineer as they are yet to complete their requisite length of service, hence, all the vacant posts have been diverted towards Degree Holders in terms of recruitment rules in vogue; and

WHEREAS, in compliance to O.M No. GAD/MTG/RB-IV/ 04/2016 dated 21.06.2016 of General Administration Department, Thirty Three (33) Posts (Degree) of Assistant Executive Engineers (Civil) have been kept reserved in earlier placements; and

WHEREAS, after applying the roster and further keeping the slots/ vacancies reserved for various reserved categories as per GAD O.M No. GAD/MTG/RB-IV/04/2016 dated 21.06.2016, 03 more posts are to be kept unfilled in favour of Degree Holders. Accordingly, total slots after reservation comes to 36 in favour of Degree holders.

WHEREAS, for the purpose of placement, Final Seniority List of Junior Engineers (Civil) Degree holders issued vide Govt. Order No. 460-PW(R&B) of 2019 dated 22.01.2019 have been taken into account. Two streams are available for making above mentioned promotion from AEE to Xen:

- 1. AEE Degree Holder (Promotee)
- 2. AEE Diploma Holder (Promotee)

WHEREAS, the claim of AEs appointed through JKPSC (Direct Recruit) in 2007 has not been considered as they were placed as I/c AEE in the year 2012 while as the Engineers who are falling under consideration zone for placement as Executive Engineers were placed as I/c AEs on 28-12-2001 and AEE on 26-10-2005.

NOW, therefore, sanction is hereby accorded to the placement of following eligible I/C Assistant Executive Engineers (Civil) as I/C Executive Engineers (Civil) Degree in their own pay and grade for a period of six months or till confirmation by the JKPSC, whichever is earlier:-

The above placement shall be subject to the following conditions:-

- That they shall not have any preferential right for promotion at the time of regularization/ confirmation through PSC/ DPC;
- The outcome of writ petition(s) pending, if any, before any competent court(s) of law.
