Whereas, one Sh. Ab. Majid Bhat was working as Helper in (R&B) Division Qazigund, died in harness on 15-10-2018, as reported by SHO Police Station Qazigund vide Registration No.330-15-B dated 22-10-2018; and

Whereas, Chief Engineer PW(R&B) Department Kashmir vide communication No. CE/RBK/ADM/ 27620-21 dated 05.02.2020 forwarded the compassionate appointment case of Sh. Shabir Ahmad Bhat S/o Late Ab. Majid Bhat R/o Yorekoshpora Anantnag, Tehsil Qazigund District Anantnag in terms of SRO-43; and

Whereas, Shri Ab. Majid Bhat, left behind his bereaved family consisting of six (06) family members i.e wife, three sons, and two daughters as per the dependent certificate issued by the Addl. Deputy Commissioner Anantnag vide No.783/ LH/Dep/Sro-43 dated 30.11.2018; and

Whereas, as reported by Sub Divisional Magistrate Dooru vide his letter No.SDM/D/2019-20/1022 dated 14-12-2019 the following members were dependent on the deceased employee:-

Whereas, Sh. Shabir Ahmad Bhat son of the deceased applied on 1.11.2018 for appointment on compassionate grounds under the provisions of SRO-43 of 1994 dated

Whereas, the Chief Engineer PW(R&B) Department Kashmir furnished the following details of the case vide his communication No. CE/RBK/ADM/27620-21 dated 05.02.2020 for compassionate appointment as per Circular No. 07 of 2006 date

Whereas, the case was examined in the Department and it was found that the beneficiary is 10th pass and in pursuance of SRO- 99 of 2008, dated 07-04-2008, issued by the General AdministrationDepartment, the minimum and maximum qualification for appointment to any Class-IV post has been prescribed as Matriculation or 10+2; and

Whereas, the beneficiary as per date of birth i.e. 27-01-1979 was 39 years, 08 months, 18 days at the time of death of his father, and as on 1st January, 2020 the applicant was over aged by 11 months and 05 days thereby falls within the ambit of relaxation of upper age bar and the powers for relaxation in upper age bar vests with the Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor; and

Whereas, Public Works (R&B) Department, with the prior approval of the Hon'ble Advisor Incharge PW (R&B) Department submitted the case to General Administration Department vide U.O No. PW/R&B/CA/08/2020 dated 10.08.2020 for seeking relaxation of upperage bar; and

Whereas, the General Administration Department vide UO No. GDC-152/CM/2020-SRO dated 30.09.2020 returned the case with following observations:-

Returned. The department is informed that the case of the applicant is not covered under SRO-43/relaxation policy in vogue.

Whereas, the above observations of GAD were conveyed to Chief Engineer PW(R&B) Department Kashmir vide communication No. PW/R&B/CA/08/2020 dated 08.10.2020; and

Whereas, aggrieved of the above action, Shri Shabir Ahmad Bhat filed a case in the Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal (CAT) titled Shabir Ahmad Bhat Vs UT of J&K praying therein for the following reliefs:-

a. to quash communication No. PW(R&B)CA/08/2020 dated 08.10.2020 addressed to Chief Engineer R&B Kashmir.

b. to quash UO No. GDC-152/CM/2020-SRO dated 30.09.2020 of GAD whereby the case of applicant was not found covered under SRO- 43.



Whereas, the Hon'ble CAT disposed off the aforesaid case videorder dated 07.04.2021, the operative part of which is reproduced as under:-

The Star of the Milling

Looking at the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the applicant, we dispose of the OA with the direction to the respondents to pass a reasoned and speaking order mentioning the reasons for rejecting the claim of the applicant for grant of compassionate appointment within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order."

Whereas, the case of the applicant was re-examined in the Department and it was found that since the applicant requires relaxation in the uper age bar for which the Hon'ble L.G is the competent authority and to whom the case was recommended through GAD in co-ordination which was however returned with the observation that the case is not covered by SRO-43/ Policy in vogue regulating compassionate appointment. In absence of relaxation in upper age bar by the competent authority, the department is not empowered to appoint the petitioner on compassionate grounds; and

Whereas, the department has again taken up the matter with the General Administration Department vide OM No. PWD-LIT/205/2021 dated 17.09.2021 with the request to provide necessary inputs to this department; and

Whereas, General Administration Department vide his OM No. GAD-SRO/384/2021-09-GAD dated 06.01.2022 has intimated that in terms of SRO-165 dated 09.06.2014, the upper age limit for entry into Government Service has been prescribed as 40 years. The petitioner was overaged by 11 months & 05 days as on 01.01.2020, the date on which his age was to be reckoned, and as such the case was rejected.

Now, therefore, in view of the above facts and position, the claim of the petitioner has been found devoid of merit.
