

## Government of Jammu and Kashmir Public Works (R&B) Department Civil Secretariat, Jammu/Srinagar

Subject: PE-SLKB-12/2020 & JSK-07/2020-Issuance of warning to the delinquent Engineers.

Government Order No: -514-PW(R&B) of 2023

Dated: 19 .12.2023

Whereas, the General Administration Department forwarded a communication No.ACB-PE-SLKB-12/2020-1409-10 Dated: 22.01.2022, of Anti Corruption Bureau J&K alongwith draft article of charges for further necessary action in the matter.

Whereas, GAD vide this communication intimated that a preliminary enquiry was conducted by ACB of different divisions of PWD (R&B) against engineers who macadamized the roads during 2015-2019 in Jammu & Kashmir and thereby created unpaid work-done liabilities on account of macadamization of roads for the period 2015-16 to 2018-19.

Whereas, the ACB in the instant PE, alleged as under:-

- i. That many works were executed without accord of Administrative approval.
- ii. That works were executed beyond the estimated costs without due concurrence.
- iii. That in some cases it was observed that works have been executed without tenders.

Whereas, the GAD/ACB advised this Department to initiate RDA against the 96 delinquent Engineers.

Whereas, the GAD/ACB did not categorize the omission and commissions of the engineers who were associated with the work. Therefore, the matter was taken up with GAD vide O.M. No. PW-HRM1/123/2021-05-dept dated. 22-12-2021.

Whereas, consequently the GAD vide U.O. No. GAD-VIG0MISC/12 / 2021-22-GAD dated: 27.05.2022, conveyed its decision / direction on the subject to this Department for categorization of engineers as per the magnitude of their delinquency.

Whereas, as per the direction of the GAD, 96 Engineers were categorized into three categories, based on extension of work less than 10%, extension of works beyond 10% and execution of non tendered/non approved works.

Whereas, after categorizing of the Engineers, this Department informed the GAD vide O.M. No. PWD-HRM1/123/2021-05-Department of PWD R&B(C.No. 70770) dated: 03.06.2022, and also shared its proposed course of action in the instant matter.

Whereas, GAD constituted a committee vide G.O. No. 18-JK-GAD(Vig) of 2023 dated: 13.03.2023 to examine the modalities submitted by PW(R&B) in connection with

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the said PE and to suggest a suitable course of action against the accused Engineers as recommended by the ACB.

Whereas, the GAD vide O.M. No. GAD-VIG0MISC/12/2021-02-GAD intimated that the committee constituted for the purpose submitted its report on 26.04.2023, with the following recommendations:

- i. "In case of works which have been executed without inviting tenders or extensions have been made without approval or validation from Competent Authority, a regular departmental action may be initiated against the responsible engineers for violation of codal formalities and causing serious irregularities.
- ii. In case of works which have been executed after floating of tenders and thereafter scope of work has been extended with approval from the appropriate authorities, a formal warning may be administered upon all such engineers for not obtaining prior AA/TS, which, however has been accorded post-facto."

Whereas, the GAD further intimated that the report/recommendations of the committee were placed before the Competent Authority, who accepted the aforesaid recommendations with the following addition:-

"Provided that the senior Authority had the competence to approve such extensions in accordance with Financial Code/Rules in vogue. However, such extensions should have not led to the change in scope of work or were violative of CVC guidelines."

Whereas, the case was further examined as per directions conveyed by GAD and viz a viz article of charges received from GAD/ACB against each Engineer.

Whereas, out of total 96 Engineers, 69 have attained superannuation and are beyond the purview of Article 168-A of JKCSR, and 27 are still under the ambit of Article 168 A of JKCSR.

Whereas, vide Government Order NO. No.309-PW(R&B) of 2023 dated 27.07.2023, followed by corrigendum NO. 383-PW(R&B) of 2023 dated 20.09.2023 with the approval of competent authorities, the case in respect of 16 engineers was closed with a strict warning to remain careful in future, while discharging duties and to strictly adhere to the codal formalities prescribed under GFR-2017 and in respect of 68 Engineers, competent authority has expressed his displeasure who attained superannuation and were beyond the ambit of Article 168-A, JKCSR.

Whereas, vide Government Order No.309-PW(R&B) of 2023 dated 27.07.2023 Er. Parkash Chander Tanoch, Development Commissioner Works (Now EIC), PW(R&B) Department was appointed as Inquiry Officer and Er. Saleem-ul -Saba, I/C Superintending Engineer PW(R&B) Jammu-Kathua Circle shall be the presenting officer to enquire into the allegations leveled against 10 delinquent Engineers including Er. Tanvir Mir, the then Executive Engineer, R&B LRCR(Left River Circular Road).

Whereas, ACB, alleged that (i) 03 No. of works executed without inviting tenders and (ii) 14 No.s works were granted extension beyond 10% during the period of Er. Tanvir Mir, as Executive Engineer R&B LRCR.

Whereas, Engineer in Chief (EIC) Inquiry Officer in respect of point No. (1) above whas reported that 03 works were executed by the delinquent officer on approval basis

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works were executed after the floods to restore the major arterial roads of interior city as the road surface was severely damaged by the floods. Due to exigency the works were taken upon on emergent basis and has been instructed by the then higher authorities. These works were executed in SDRF which later paid by her successor. No liability on this account has been created and as regards point No. (ii) the IO has reported that as per list submitted by ACB only 11 No. of works has been shown with extension beyond 10% instead of 14 No. Works. 14 works mentioned in the list , only one work was etendered during the tenure of delinquent officer and was allotted by the then Superintending Engineer (R&B) Circular Road Project vide his allotment No. SE/CRP/REC-125/7562-65 dated 5.10.2015 for an allotted amount of Rs. 125.1 Lacs against advertised cost of Rs. 139.00 lacs , however, the payment was made by Er. Tanvir Mir's Successor.

The Inquiry Officer recommended charges leveled against the Engineer may be dropped and RDA be closed with warning to be careful and vigilant in future.

Now, therefore, in light of the above and by upholding the recommendation of Engineer in Chief (DCW), with the prior approval of the Competent Authority, the allegations leveled against Er. Tanvir Mir, the then Executive Engineer R&B LRCR is dropped and case is hereby closed with warning to remain cautious, vigilant and careful in future while discharging duties.
