Subject: Regularization of Engineers (Civil) – Submission of APRs and other requisite documents.


NOTICE

The Department is in the process of submitting a proposal to the General Administration Department for placing before Establishment-cum-Selection-Committee for considering regularization of In-charge Chief Engineers (Civil) as Chief Engineers (Civil). However, during examination, it has been found that many engineers have not submitted complete APRs of the relevant period, Work & Conduct/Integrity Certificates and Vigilance clearance. The Department has time and again informed all the engineers to upload their APRs and other requisite documents on the portal of this Department i.e, JKPWDOMS and posting details on VC portal however, still many of the engineers have failed to adhere to the instructions issued from time to time.

Therefore, the following In-charge Chief Engineers (retired/in-service) of Civil Wing are advised to upload their APRs for the last 05 years and their Work & Conduct and Integrity certificates on JKPWDOMS and posting details on VC portal, if not already uploaded, within ten (10) days time positively enabling this Department to consider their cases for promotion/regularization:-
